Marie has thirty years' experience in the library and information sector in libraries such as King's Inns, Technological University Dublin, Waterford Regional Hospital, the Welsh Office, University College Dublin and the Oireachtas. Marie is also the former Head of Dublin Business School Library, winner of the *Best Library Team* category at the Education Awards. Marie is the originator and co-founder of the MSc in Information and Library Management at Dublin Business School which is accredited by the Library Association of Ireland. More recently Marie has held posts in academic enhancement and teaching and learning at CCT College Dublin.
